An infrequently heard instrument...

The Erhu most likely evolved from the Xquin, an instrument that originated from the Xi people of Central Asia, arriving in China in the 10th century. Though once played with a rosined stick, the horse hair bow is now used. The Erhu consists of a long vertical stick-like neck with two large tuning pegs at the top, and a small resonating body at the bottom. There is no fingerboard, per se; the player's fingertips are pressed into the strings but the strings never touch the neck. Strings were originally made from silk but have been replaced by nylon and steel. This is a most versatile instrument and is used in traditional music as well as contemporary arrangements of many styles.
